STANDARD RATE SEARCH REQUEST - CUSTOMER INFORMATION

The fee for Rate Search is per rates assessment.

- e.g. 4 lots of land on the one rates notice 1 Standard rate fee charge
 - 4 lots of land on separate rates notices 4 Standard rate fee charge

The following information is included on a Rate Search

- Property Details
- Local Authority Valuation of Land
- Currently quarterly rates and date to which same have been paid
- The amount of arrears of rates (if applicable)

Cheque – Council will only accept Cheque (Bank or Personal) or Money Orders to be in Australian Dollars only, cheques are payable to Blackall-Tambo Regional Council.

Credit Card – Contact Council to arrange to pay

In Person - Pay with cash, cheque, Eftpos or Credit Card at the Administration Officer between 8.30am to 4.30pm Monday to Friday.

Please be aware that this search does not include identification of existing easements – see official title deed at Department of Natural Resources and Mines.

Water Meters

Residential premises in the township of Blackall-Tambo do not currently have water meters connected.
