BLACKALL HEAVY VEHICLE BYPASS

Council will be commencing work on the bypass road in the coming weeks with the first stage occurring at the truck parking area at the Blackall Saleyards. Work for the bypass will affect traffic using Evora Road and Violet Street however, it is anticipated that the impact will be minimal.

BARCOO RIVER BRIDGE - TAMBO

Work has commenced for the Barcoo River Bridge project in Tambo. RoadTek arrived at the construction site on 19 April and piling to commence shortly. While the piling is occurring, there will be noise between the hours of 7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday which could create a disturbance.

For the duration of the project the Coolibah Walking Trail and access to the Qantas Crash Site will be closed. Council apologises for any inconvenience this may cause.
