DID YOU KNOW – Gravel Resheeting

Unsealed roads lose gravel over time and require the placement of additional gravel. This process is called 'resheeting' and involves placing an additional layer of compacted gravel on top of the existing road.

Gravel is placed in a layer of approximately 100mm to 150mm and is worked with graders, rollers and water trucks. As the gravel is spread a water truck adds moisture to aid compaction. The roller passes over the gravel to lightly compact the road.

It is generally not economical for Council to upgrade all roads to a bitumen standard as this requires higher quality pavements and ongoing bitumen resealing and rehabilitation expenses.

Generally a gravel road will require resheeting every 7-12 years depending on the type of gravel, traffic volume and weather conditions.
