REGIONAL WORKS

Relining Solutions have been contracted to complete sewer relining of identified sections in town.

The program has been funded by the Works for Queensland Program that supports regional councils to undertake job-creating and minor infrastructure projects.

Work on the Shamrock St median strip will commence on 8 May. The work will start at the Hawthorn Street end of Shamrock Street.
