The Blackall-Tambo Regional Council have local laws that deal with many matters some of which are as follows:

Keeping and control of animals in the region Minimum standards for keeping of animals Control of animals

Fires and fire hazards

Overgrown/unsightly allotments

Local pests

Electric and barb wire fencing

Council generally operates on complaints. If complaints are made, the local laws need to be enforced.
