REGIONAL WORKS

Sewer relining for Blackall will be commencing the week of 27 March 2023. Impacted residents will be notified by a letterbox drop. The service will not be restricted.

Specialized parts have had to be ordered for the Tambo Pool. This is causing further delays. Once the parts have arrived and been fitted it should take approximately 1 week to treat the water.

Roadworks are underway at the Blackall Saleyards to accommodate the extensions at the yards and additional parking for trucks.

Rehabilitation work is occurring on the Isisford–Blackall Road.

Crews will start working on the re-sheeting of the Springsure-Tambo Road commencing 27 March 2023.

The Heavy Vehicle Bypass is now fully complete and open to the public. Traffic must be mindful that the signals have changed and vehicles on the Evora Road must now give way to the Bypass. Vehicles on Rose Street must now give way to Violet Street.
