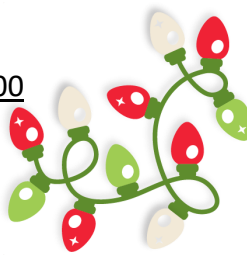

REGIONAL WORKS

This past month Blackall-Tambo Regional Council has taken ownership of some long awaited plant items including a CAT RM500 Rotary Mixer and a Deutz-Fahr Tractor for the Tambo Grid Roller. These machines will ensure that Council can produce better road projects now and well into the future.

The Tambo Construction Crew have been resheeting the Mt Playfair Road and paving the Tambo Cemetery Roads with crusher dust. The crusher dust will ensure easier access by the public.

The Blackall Construction Crew have completed an initial seal on the Heavy Vehicle Bypass which will see this project come closer to completion with a secondary seal to follow in December prior to opening to traffic.

The Blackall Services Crew have installed two shade structures at the Four Mile Water Hole just in time for summer.

The Blackall Handyman has been hard at work installing the new street climber and soft-fall in Banks Park. The new play equipment will soon be open to public access.
