REGIONAL WORKS

Wet Day but no play, both depots took advantage of the stand down in road works to undertake some much needed maintenance on equipment and town beautification projects.

The Barcoo River Bridge is now sealed but due to safety restrictions will not be opened to the public until the guardrail is installed.

The Blackall-Isisford Road is undergoing a rehabilitation project approximately 13kms from Blackall, this project is 8kms long and will be underway from now until December. This project will require the use of a temporary side-track at various times over the coming months. In the initial stages culvert installation is underway and this may result in closing of the road or restrictions in wet weather as we have experienced over the past two weeks. Once the culverts are installed this restriction will be lessened as we can utilise the existing road when required.

BLACKALL-EMMET ROAD

There has been some concern raised over the Blackall-Emmet road no longer being all weather. Due to severe potholing and irreparable damage four sections along the road have been temporarily reverted to gravel as a safety precaution. These sections will be converted back to bitumen in conjunction with the Blackall-Isisford Rehabilitation works prior to Christmas 2022. This will ensure all weather travel for the holiday season and beyond. Other major works will be undertaken on this road in the new year such as concrete margins, resealing and signage replacement.

Due to recent weather many shire roads may be closed or subject to restrictions over the coming weeks. Please check the Council website or Facebook page for updates on the road conditions.
